ENROLMENT COSTS

Application Fee: A non-refundable fee of \$100 must accompany each Enrolment Application or \$100 per family where more than one child is being enrolled at the one time. Later enrolment of siblings will incur an additional fee. This Application Fee does not guarantee an offer for placement.

Enrolment Deposit: A start-up fee of \$500 is to be paid prior to commencement. This fee comes off the total tuition fee.

2019 Additional Information

LEVIES

- A Maintenance Levy per family of \$100 is charged per term. This levy is credited at the end of each term if a minimum of 4 hours service is given to the College per term.
- On rare occasions Programs & Electives may attract nominal additional charges, these are kept to a minimum.
- A re-enrolment fee may be payable if an enrolment is ended due to non-payment of fees.

IPADS

- Year 7–10 students require an iPad. Parents should be aware that this represents an additional cost. Connect with the Head of Secondary or e-Learning coordinator for details.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE

- After School Care is provided externally by Camp Australia. Please refer to www.campaustralia.com.au for more information about their program and costs involved.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- Fees are billed on an annual basis.
- If the whole year's fees are paid in full by the end of the second week of term 1 you will receive a discount of 5%.
- Otherwise, the option for fee payment is termly or monthly instalments. Other arrangements can be made with the Accounts Department.
- A late payment administration fee of \$30 (incl. GST) may be applied to your account when it is overdue or a payment is dishonoured by your bank.
- One term's notice in writing is required when a student is to be withdrawn from the College or one term's fees paid in lieu of notice will be charged.
- If students are absent from school for family holidays, overseas travel or personal reasons, fees are still to be paid during that time. Refunds are not given for students who do not complete a school term or do not participate in a required activity.

BUILDING FUND

- The College undertakes new buildings from time to time. Contributions from families are encouraged. Donate to the Building Fund. A suggested amount of \$500 is shown on a building fund notice and all donations are tax deductible.
