CONCESSIONS – TUITION FEE DISCOUNT

Families can avail of 50% discount on tuition fee if you hold an eligible:

- Centrelink pensioner or concession or health care card
- Veteran's affairs pensioner (gold card)
- Foster parent under a temporary care order

CONCESSIONS – FAMILY DISCOUNT

These apply where more than one child from the immediate family is enrolled.

2 nd child	15% off 2 nd child's fees
3 rd child	30% off 3rd child's fees
4 ^{th+} child	70% off 4 th + child's fees

ENROLMENT COSTS

APPLICATION FEES

A non-refundable fee of \$100 must accompany each application or \$100 per family where application relates to more than one child. All subsequent children enrolled at a later date will require an additional payment of \$100. This Application Fee does not guarantee an offer for placement.

ENROLMENT DEPOSIT

A non-refundable enrolment fee of \$500 is to be paid on Acceptance of Offer of Enrolment. This deposit fee is credited to the total tuition fee.

2026 Additional Financial Information

INVOICING - Fees are billed on an annual basis at the beginning of Term 1.

DISCOUNTS - A 5% discount is given when the fees are paid in full by the end of the second week of Term 1.

NON-ATTENDANCE - If students are absent from school for family holidays, overseas travel or personal reasons, fees are still to be paid during that time. Refunds are not given for students who do not complete a school term or do not participate in the required activity.

STUDENT WITHDRAWAL

Notification to withdraw and charges will be as follows:

- One term notice in writing is required when a student is to be withdrawn from the College, or
- If one's term notice is not given, fees will be charged in lieu of notice.

LEVIES

- On rare occasions Programs & Electives may attract nominal additional charges, these are kept to a minimum.
- A re-enrolment fee may be payable if enrolment is ended due to non-payment of fees.

LAPTOPS, BOOKS & STATIONERY

- Tuition covers the cost of school uniforms, excursions and camps.
- A personal laptop is required for online learning and must be purchased separately from our supplier.
- Textbooks and stationery are not included in the tuition fees. Please refer to the school website for booklist and ordering details.

BUILDING FUND

The College undertakes new buildings from time to time and contributions from families are encouraged. A suggested amount of \$500 is shown on a Building Fund Donation notice and all donations are tax deductible.

HOW TO PAY FEES

- Paid upfront in full for the whole year prior to commencement, OR
- Direct debit with payment cycles of weekly, fortnightly or monthly done through our payment portal FACTS Tuition Management.
- An administration fee of \$33 will be applied to your account for dishonoured payments.
- All fees must be paid by the end of the school year.
